Half termly theme: People Jesus Meets Focus this week: : Luke 4.1-13 The Tempter



This week we talked about when Jesus was led by God into the barren wilderness region between Jerusalem and the Dead Sea. His time was spent in prayer and fasting as he prepared for all that ley ahead. His mind was focussed on doing God's, however the devil tried to temp Jesus three times when he knew that Jesus was tired, hungry and thirsty. ### In the news this week

45-year-old Mar Galcerán from Spain has become the country's first elected parliame entarian with Down's syndrome. Maria del Mar Galcerán Gadea is thought to be the first person with the genetic disorder to join a European regional or national parliament. She has been involved with politics since she was 18, when she joined Spain's conservative People's Party. Speaking to the media, Mar Galcerán said she wants to be seen as a person, and not for her disability.
