


Middleforth Church of England Primary School

Nursery Outdoor Area Development

We are currently looking at developing the outdoor area for our new nursery to create an imaginative and innovative play area. We would like to develop the unused stepped area beside the nursery (this was previously the library). Our proposed design includes a three tier play area with a range of safe surfaces, an integral staging area and a sand pit and climbing/sliding equipment. The Big Lottery Fund are keen to hear parent's views which will support our bid. If the bid is successful it will fund a large proportion of the project. Mobile Phones

A reminder that our school policy is that mobile phones can only be brought into school with permission from parents and they cannot be used on school grounds. If you have not consented already please can you ensure you sign the approval for us so that we know that you have given permission and your child understands the rules regarding storing the mobile phones. If your child brings a phone in after half term and we do not have a permission from you we will contact you to collect the phone from the school office rather than return it to your child.

Please help us with GDPR, Consent, School Photographs etc

On the Wednesday after half term, Tempest Photography will be taking individual photographs of all children in school. We are unable to take any photographs of your child if you have not yet given your consent using the survey that has been sent out to all parents. This can be accessed via the website by clicking on the parent log in (this will not work on a mobile phone or tablet) or by downloading the school spider app on your mobile or tablet. You will need to click on the settings symbol (cog wheel) at the top of the page to log in.

The survey is very simple and you just need to click on a radio button O answering yes or no for each question. Since GDPR came into force in May the questions we need to ask are much more detailed. The survey system has been invaluable and we would like to thank the 85% of parents that are now using this system. If you need any help accessing the website parent log in / spider app there will be an informal drop in session for parents from 3pm-3.30pm on Monday 29th October.

World War 1 Remembrance Week

As part of our World War 1 Remembrance Week we have been invited by St. Leonard's Parish Church to join them in making poppies to go on display outside of Church. Attendance

It is really important that your child attends school every day. The government level at which a child is considered a persistent absentee and therefore at risk of not making the progress they should in school is 90%. At the end of each half term we will send out a letter to any parents where a child has attendance below this figure and if we are not aware of extenuating circumstances for the absence will ask you to come in for a meeting to discuss ways we can improve their absence. Once attendance falls below 85% it is likely that we will have to request support from the county attendance team for your child.

Watch this space – Seesaw

After half term we will be launching Seesaw for parents. This is a means of seeing your child's work and activities by using an APP. We feel this will be a great opportunity for us to share parts of your child's learning journey in school with you. Before we launch this we will need all the parents in each class to agree to us sharing photos of your child with other parents in the class as sometimes your child may be on a photo of another child. Please watch out for a letter requesting consent and also a parent session where we will show you how this will work.
