Welcome back! It is great to have everyone back safely in school. As we now move into a wider lockdown, we wanted to update you on how things are operating in school. We have a wide range of robust and detailed plans and procedures that are in place. These are designed to keep every member of the school community as safe as possible.

Measures include the bubble system, whereby one class does not come into direct contact with another. More rigorous cleaning protocols are in place including increased cleaning throughout the day and before and after school, and regular handwashing and sanitising also occur at regular intervals during the school day. School staff wear face coverings at any point they are in communal areas and some staff may choose to wear a face covering when working with children. As we move forward, we will continue to implement these procedures and revise them if necessary based on new information or any further guidance that may be published.

What is crucial now is that you support us and follow the new lockdown restrictions to keep our whole school community safe. When you are picking children up from school please socially distance from each other and please ensure you wear a face covering during drop off and pick up and communicate this to anyone providing childcare. Please also ensure you are following the new laws around the new lockdown and children are not meeting up outside of school under the current regulations.

The most important message, at present, is that we are open for all children and it is vital that they are in school each day where they can get the best possible education. Before and after school club will continue as normal and the structure of the school day will be maintained as it is now.

Please ensure that you continue to follow the guidance around isolation and inform us immediately of any positive cases so we can take the appropriate action. Please be assured that we have very strict guidelines to follow regarding closure of bubbles and the communication of this, and a team are involved in every decision to ensure that we are always fully compliant. Where necessary we involve Public Health England to help us make the correct decisions.

We pray that we can maintain as much normality as possible this half term as we approach Christmas and keep as many of us safe, healthy and in school as possible.

Please be aware that we use pre-booked meals to determine the kitchen food order numbers for the following week. Children who don't have a pre-booked meal, may not receive the meal of their choice.

Wraparound Care

Thank you all for adhering to the rules of booking a week in advance, this has been incredibly helpful and made such a difference in planning our staffing numbers. Please can you continue do this as we make our plans every Friday afternoon for the week following. Breakfast and After School clubs are booked online via ScoPay. It is best to avoid using the app and going directly to the webpage.

Attendance/Absences

Please can we remind you of the importance in contacting school if your child is going to be absent on a school day. If your child is going to be absent due to illness, you must contact the office before 9.00am. If you are reporting outside of school hours or the phoneline is busy, you can email, text or leave a message on the answerphone. If we have not heard from or been able to make contact with a parent/carer at the time of registration, we are obliged by LCC to report that child as missing.

If your child is going to be absent from school for a medical appointment, please advise the office of the date and time. Ideally, making appointments outside of school hours would be advisable, however, where this is unavoidable we need advance notification. If you are taking your child out of school for any other reason, such as a holiday or celebration etc, you must complete a LCC leave of absence form which are available from the school office.
