Drinks in school.

We place great importance on children staying hydrated throughout the day in school, but it is really important that everyone adheres to our rule of only providing water for your children for their classroom drink. It is causing problems in many of our classes that some children are bringing in different drinks. Sweet drinks cause us a multitude of problems, especially when they are spilt and they stain our carpets and soft furnishings or other children's work, leave sticky spills which attract ants and insects and cause a feeling of unfairness between the children.

Free School Meals (Pupil Premium)

Just a reminder that in addition to all infant children (Reception to Y2) being eligible for Universal Free School Meals, all children from **Reception to Year 6** may be able to get free school meals if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get).

In addition to your child receiving free school meals, schools receive valuable funding of £1,345 per pupil to help improve progress for children who may need it.

You can apply to check your eligibility <u>at any time</u>, as understandably, family circumstances may change and especially in the current uncertain times we are facing.

<u>School Meal Bookings – ParentPay, 'New Menus'</u>



The Autumn/Winter menu started on Monday 9th November and will run into the Spring term. Please remember to continue keeping your bookings up to date via ParentPay, as far as you possibly can as it really is a great help.

Christmas Dinner for Wednesday 16th December is being added to ParentPay. Apologies, but if you had previously made a booking for this day, you will need to rebook for Turkey or Quorn Christmas Dinner. <u>There are no other menu choices available on this day</u>,

children can still bring their own packed lunch from home and sit with their friends for lunch.

Please be aware that we use pre-booked meals to determine the kitchen food order numbers for the following week. Children who don't have a pre-booked meal, may not receive the meal of their choice.

Wraparound Care

Thank you all for adhering to the rules of booking a week in advance, this has been incredibly helpful and made such a difference in planning our staffing numbers. Please can you continue do this as we make our plans every Friday afternoon for the week following. Breakfast and After School clubs are booked online via ScoPay.

You may be eligible for tax free childcare through Gov.uk where you'll set up an online childcare account for your child. For every £8 you pay into this account, the government will pay an additional £2 to use to pay for your wrap around care. To find out more click here.

Attendance/Absences

Please can we remind you of the importance in contacting school if your child is going to be absent on a school day. If your child is going to be absent due to illness, you must contact the office before 9.00am. If you are reporting outside of school hours or the phoneline is busy, you can email, text or leave a message on the answerphone. If we have not heard from or been able to make contact with a parent/carer at the time of registration, we are obliged by LCC to report that child as missing.

If your child is going to be absent from school for a medical appointment, please advise the office of the date and time. Ideally, making appointments outside of school hours would be advisable, however, where this is unavoidable we need advance notification. If you are taking your child out of school for any other reason, such as a holiday or celebration etc, you must complete a LCC leave of absence form which are available from the school office.
